

Renovation of the Artists Gallery

Dear EAA Members.

The Artists Gallery is under renovation. Starting Saturday, February 27 we will be repairing the ceiling, putting up and repairing slat wall panels, cleaning the window area and painting. In order to accomplish the renovation, **we will need to have all art, cards and prints removed from the gallery by Friday, February 26.** If you cannot personally remove your work, please authorize another to do so. EAA is not responsible for items left behind and/or damaged.

After the renovation we will be installing Gallery quality lighting.

The gallery has purchased a 65" rotating card rack for artists to display their cards. All artists who would like to display cards may share this card rack (with Gallery Director approval). Other card holders and racks will no longer be allowed in the gallery. Cards must be sealed in clear wrap and have the price marked on each card and must be changed every couple of months. (There are cards in the gallery with artists names that I do not recognize.)

Take-in for the March Little Paintings show for members (no larger than 12" x 12") will take place on Saturday, March 6 from 11am – 4pm or Monday, March 8 from 4pm – 6pm.

Starting March 6, there will be pedestals or glass shelves in the gallery for rent at \$5/sq ft per month. And wall rental space approximately 8' x 4' for rent at \$50/month. Contact the Gallery Director at eaa121grand@gmail.com if you are interested in renting space.

The Artists Gallery is open: Wed thru Sat 11:00 am - 4:00 pm


Viewing of artwork inside the gallery will follow strict COVID-19 protocols, socially distancing and wearing masks.

EAA 2021 Art Scholarship Program

The EAA's 2021 Art Scholarship Program for graduating seniors currently enrolled in any Escondido-based high school will be sponsored, once again, through the generosity of Design-Moe Kitchen & Bath, Escondido. A total of \$1,000 in Scholarship money will be awarded as follows: \$500-First Place, \$250-Second Place, \$150-Third Place, and two \$50 Honorable Mention awards. In order to compete, students must: (1) fill out a Scholarship Application/ Entry Form; (2) obtain a letter of recommendation from their scholarship coordinator/art teacher; (3) write an essay about their interest in art; and (4) submit three pieces of artwork (at least one original.)

Drop-off dates have been extended one week and completed packages must be submitted to the Artists Gallery at 121 W. Grand Avenue by Saturday, March 6, 2021 from 11:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m. or Monday, March 8, 2021, from 4:00–6:00 p.m. Winners will be notified by March 10th, and artwork will remain on exhibit through April 2nd. Pickup must be made on April 3rd from 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. A Reception and Awards Ceremony is still to be determined based on Covid-19 restrictions in place during the month of March. 
